Bap 1558-1669/70, mar 1559/60-1658, banns 1653-55/6, bur 1558-1669: entered in two concurrent series, one parchment, the other paper. Ms. 10,343 is probably the original paper reg. of which Ms. 10,342 is the parchment copy; but the subsequent relationship of the two series is not known. The entries in each series are usually identical, but there are some gaps in the series of paper reg.
