angle westerly one hundred feet; thence at a right angle northerly fifty feet; thence at a right angle westerly fifty feet; thence at a right angle northerly one hundred feet to the southerly line of Bosworth Street; thence easterly along said line of Bosworth Street fifty feet; thence at a right angle southerly one hundred feet; thence easterly at a right angle one hundred feet to the westerly line of Marsily Street and the point of commencement.
